### Introduction

After another successful year delivering training across Leeds, with a total of 479 delegates attending our courses from Leeds and wider, we are now focusing on our 2025/26 provision.

We are thrilled to announce we have expanded our Vacc & Imms training provision to include a 2-day course for new clinical staff, an in-person training session offering both competencies based, theory and practical learning over 2 days. This is on top of our existing Vacc & Imms provision, with a range of courses commencing in May.

In other exciting news we have linked up with the West Yorkshire Workforce Training Hub so that staff eligible for their £333 CPD training funds can now apply for this to use on Leeds GP Confederation (Confed) training.
